9* MOTION - (MEMBER FOR BANGALE)

THAT, aware that Bangale Ward is one of the areas adversely affected by the ongoing drought; further aware that this has resulted in human suffering and massive livestock loss; appreciating that the County Government continues to supply the residents with clean water using water boozers; concerned that this is an expensive and temporary measures by the County Government in providing water service; this House urges the County Government of Tana River to set aside funds for the construction of a water pipeline to provide a permanent solution to the perennial water shortage in Bangale Ward.

10 * MOTION - (MEMBER FOR CHEWELE)

THAT, aware that the Constitution of Kenya 2010 established Devolution to take services closer to the people of Kenya and improve their lives; further aware that since independence the National Government did little to improve lives of the residents of Tana River County who perceived the advent of devolution as the only way out of the shackles of marginalization; appreciating that Article 183 of the Constitution clearly spells out the functions of the County Executive in ensuring that the dream of devolution is realized; noting that Members of the County Executive Committee are accountable to the Governor for the performance and exercise of their powers pursuant to Article 179(6) of the Constitution of Kenya; concerned that the County Executive of Tana River has failed to meet the expectations of the residents of Tana River County as a result of lack of commitment, constant infightings amongst the Members of the Executive, disregard of its constitutional function including failure to submit important documents to the County Assembly and misuse of public resources; this House urges the Governor to come up with a mechanism of addressing the discord in the executive by fostering harmony and ensuring smooth service delivery to the people of Tana River.
